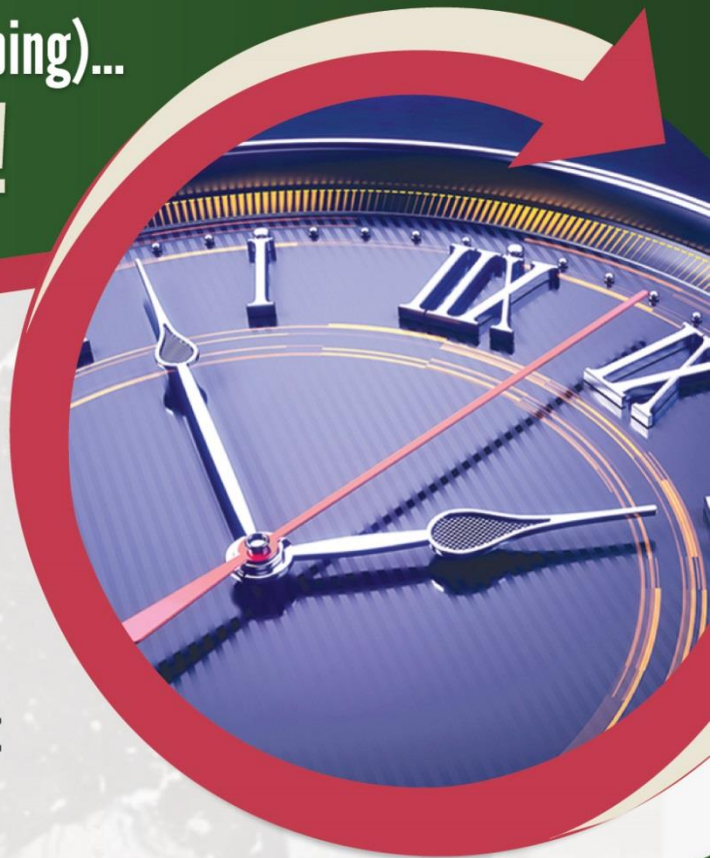

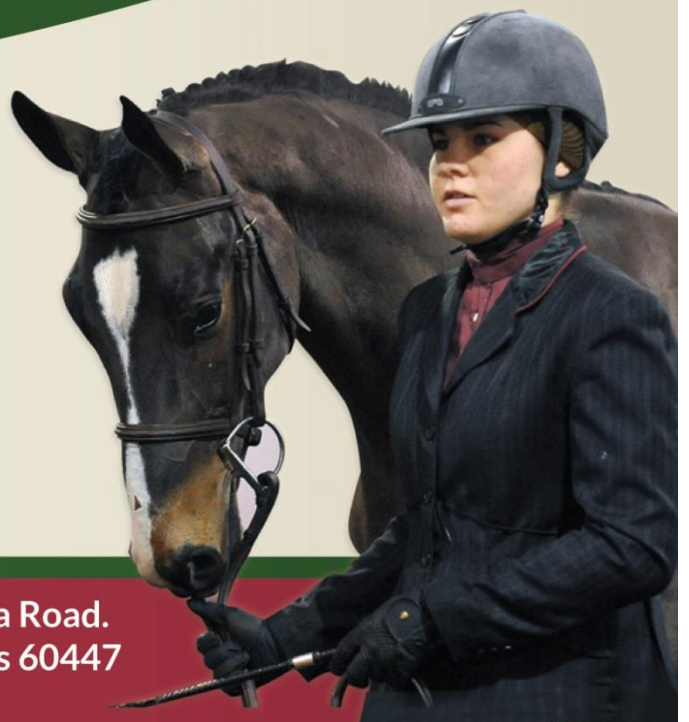

YHS General Rules and Regulations:

RULE CHANGE FOR FINALS ONLY:

All qualified horses in classes 101, 102, 103 and 104 will have the option to choose a group in which they want to compete. The options will be a Hunter/Jumper group or a Dressage group. These 2 groups will be judged and pinned independently. The prize money will be split and as follow for each group:

1st/\$200, 2nd/\$100 and 3rd/\$50. Horse can only compete in one group.

IMPORTANT NOTES FOR ALL CLASSES:

If the rider falls off or dismounts the horse for any reasons without being asked specifically by the judge, the horse and rider will be excused from the ring.

If the judge feels that the rider/horse or handler/horse combination is unsafe for anyone involved or if the horse looks irregular in his gates, the judge will excuse the said combination from the class.

All persons entering any Young Horse Show venues must be wearing adequate footwear (closed toe shoes).

Closing Date: 10/26/2015

Note: A late fee of \$25 will apply to all participants entering past the closing date.

Important: All horses that qualify on Friday will need to enter the Saturday show at the office on Friday in order to compete on Saturday. Thank you for your cooperation.

TIEC Fees:

- \$100 per horse in stall for Week End (Wed noon to Mon noon)
- \$60 per horse TIEC Grounds fee

YHS Fees:

- Qualifier YHS Office Fee: \$40/horse
- Finals YHS Office Fee: \$50/horse
- YHS OFFICE FEE FOR SCHOOLING/WARM UP ROUNDS ONLY: \$20/horse

For Bedding and Hay, please see entry form. Stalls are bare.

Scores: Each horse will receive a Final Score per qualifying class that will be based on a scale from 1 to 10 or a % for dressage tests.

Professional Handlers: Due to liability issues, professional handlers are mandatory for the in-hand and jump chute divisions. We have arranged for a minimum of two professional handlers to be present at the show. Their fees are included in the class.

Bridles: Mandatory for 2 year olds and older. Optional for yearlings. Make sure to have reins with clips that are easy to remove.

Stalls: Mandatory for all horses.

Arrival/Departure: Arrival Wed noon ok. Stalls must be vacated by Monday noon. Be sure to contact the office for exceptions.

Prizes/Prize Money:

Qualifier Classes:

1st place: \$100 - 2nd: \$50 - 3rd: \$25

Finals:

1st place: \$400 – 2nd: \$200 – 3rd: \$100

Money will be split in case of a tie.

Ribbons will be awarded to the first thru third placing in each class.

SHOW GROUND RULES AND REGULATIONS

SHOW GROUND RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Following Rules and Regulations are published by TIEC, and are issued to all riders, trainers, handlers, grooms, families and their guests. These Rules and Regulations are published for the purpose of maintaining a safe and enjoyable environment for all horses, riders, trainers, handlers, grooms, families and their guests. Violations of these rules may result in removal from the grounds.

Please help us keep the barns clean, tidy and safe by following these rules:

- Clean up after yourself-including picking up manure from the aisles, wash rack.
- Horses may not be left unattended in the aisle or wash racks.
- Hang up hoses at the wash rack and make sure the water is turned off when finished

All owners and exhibitors shall be held responsible for any damage incurred by them, their agents or employees to stalls, buildings and other properties on the show grounds, and shall be billed accordingly.

Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be secured on a leash or otherwise contained. Dogs may not be left unattended in barn aisles even if leashed. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be fined.

Equine Health Information: HEALTH DOCUMENT REQUIREMENTS

The following health documents must be presented in the horse show office for all horses on the grounds:

- 1- Negative Coggins test within one year
- 2- Proof of EHV-1/EHV-4 vaccinations, not within 7 days, not outside of 120 days
- 3- Statement of Health signed by a licensed veterinarian within 10 days of arrival at TIEC documenting that the horse has:
 - a. Received regular and consistent vaccination against Equine Influenza and EHV 1 & 4 with most recent booster being within 120 days and not within 7 days. Written statements from your Vet explaining reasons for being boosted within 180 days MAY be accepted. IN NO CASE MAY BE BOOSTER BE WITHIN 7 DAYS OR OUTSIDE OF 120 DAYS
 - b. Not shown symptoms of or been treated for EHV-1/4 within the past 28 days
 - c. Not been at a facility under quarantine for EHV-1/4 or exposed to any horses showing symptoms of EHV-1/4 within the past 28 days
- 4 - Out of state horses must have a 10-day interstate health certificate

Current vaccination against WNV, WEE, EEE, Tetanus and Rabies is strongly recommended. You should be able to document your horse's normal temperature before arrival. Please do not ship horses with elevated temperatures. It is recommended that you establish a log of temperatures taken at least twice daily. If there is an elevated temperature for more than a 24-hour period, please consult your local veterinarian immediately.

Bedding and Stabling Stalls will be available for horses participating in the event. Stalls are without bedding. All stall reservations must be made with entries. Bedding orders may be made with entries and through the show office.

Arrival and Departure

Horses may arrive on the grounds beginning at noon on Wednesday, November 4th and must vacate the property by noon on Monday, November 9th. All requests for exceptions to these times must be made through the show office.

Schooling and Lunging

Schooling is available in **designated areas only**. Lunging areas will be well marked. Please DO NOT lunge anywhere other than designated areas.

Veterinary Services A veterinarian will be on call for all horse show events and available for 24 hours a day emergencies and any health care needs. Please contact the show office in case of any vet needs.

Headgear All riders must wear protective headgear that meets ASTM/SEI standards while mounted.

Lodging

Camping/RV hook up is available on the grounds for a fee of \$150 for the week/three nights. Reservations for camping spaces must be made with entries.

HORSE SHOW TIPS

- For the in hand classes, make sure to have reins with clips that are easy to remove
- If your horse is not used to a bridle, we recommend that you practice at home a few times before the show
- Make sure your horse is clean and braided. If you cannot have your horse braided, make sure the mane is pulled and short
- Make sure your horse's feet are trimmed and clean. The trimming should be done a few days before the show to avoid soreness in the feet
- Practice the jump chute at home if possible. Do not over face your horse! The height is not important at first. You just need to build confidence.
