Health Document Requirements

The following health documents must be presented in the horse show office for all horses on grounds:

- 1. Negative Coggins test within one year
- 2. Proof of EHV-1/EHV-4 vaccinations within the past 180 days (see USEF GR845 for additional info)
- 3. Statement of Health signed by a licensed veterinarian within 30 days of arrival at TIEC documenting that the horse has:
 - a. Received regular and consistent vaccination against Equine Influenza and EHV-1/EHV-4 with most recent booster being within 180 days.

IN NO CASE MAY BOOSTER BE OUTSIDE OF 180 DAYS

- b. Not shown symptoms of or been treated for EHV-1/4 within the past 28 days.
- c. Not been at a facility under quarantine for EHV-1/4 or exposed to any horses showing symptoms for EHV-1/4 within the past 28 days.
- 4. Out of state horses must have a 30-day interstate health certificate.

Current vaccination against WNV, WEE, EEE, Tetanus, and Rabies is strongly recommended. You should be able to document your horse's normal temperature before arrival. Please do not ship horses with elevated temperatures. It is recommended that you establish a log of temperatures taken at least twice daily. If there is an elevated temperature for more than a 24-hour period, please consult with your local veterinarian immediately.
