



2024 - \$3000 YHS TEQUESTRIAN FARMS JUMPING DERBY @ TIEC

Open to all horses. Courses to have hunter/jumper/eventer jumps

All jumps will have a low and a high option. Class time: Evening.

\$100 entry fee not including stabling – see entry form

Cap: 15 per division or 30 entries total.

NEW:

- no more than 2 horses per rider per division
- all fences will have a non-eventer fence option

Division A (.90 m): 4 and 5 yo horses. Will need to provide proof of age. Bonus points at judge's discretion if Div. A horse jumps higher option. Scores based on bascule, scope, front and hind end, style, blood, carefulness, willingness, rideability and overall impression.

Round 1: Not against the clock. Horses will jump the lower option course and will receive a score from 1 to 10 based on their overall performance. Each fault (rail) or refusal will count as ½ point off their total score. After 2 refusals, horse/rider combination will be excused but given a schooling 3rd try at their discretion before exiting the ring. Jumping higher option can give the horse a bonus at the discretion of the judge. The top 5 horses will return for a second round.

Round 2: Top 5 horses to compete. Scores from round do not carry over. Horses will be required to jump another 4 to 6 fences and will be judged as in round 1.

The top 5 will be awarded prizes. 1st \$750 – 2nd \$375 – 3rd \$188 – 4th \$94 – 5th \$47

Division B (1.10m): 6 yo and above. Penalty points at judge's discretion if Div. B horse jumps lower option.

Round 1: Horses will jump the higher option course. Jumping lower option can give the horse a penalty at the discretion of the judge. Each fault (rail) or refusal will count as ½ point off their total score. After 2 refusals, horse/rider combination will be excused but given a schooling 3rd try at their discretion before exiting the ring. Scores based on bascule, scope, front and hind end, style, blood, carefulness, and willingness, rideability and overall impression. Placing based on score and clear rounds in case of a tie. The top 5 horses will return for second round.

Round 2: Jump Off. Timed. Top 5 horses to compete. 4 faults per rail. Fastest clear round wins. The top 5 will be awarded prize money. 1st \$750 – 2nd \$375 – 3rd \$188 – 4th \$94 – 5th \$47.

An Open ring will be available to all participants (no jumping) in the afternoon of the class.

Warmup ring will include a cross country jump.
