Time line: 12 months

1. Attend a YHS or a Frame Sport Horses Jump Chute clinic.

- Get in touch with the event manager to sign in prior to the event (do not just show up).
- If time and circumstances allow, you will be asked to come in the jump chute and shadow one of the handlers.

2. Attend no less than 2 YHS or Frame Sport Horses Jump Chute clinics as a support/trainee handler.

- After step 1, we will get your info and we will contact you to come and become a trainee handler.
- You will be expected to attend the show or event and work with the certified handlers.
- You will need to do this at least twice.
- Depending on the outcome and your performance of the second event, you will move to the next step or be asked to do another training session.

3. Receive a YHS certification as a Support Handler

- Participate at a YHS or Frame Sport Horses Jump Chute clinic as a Support Handler and receive your certification from YHS.
- Upon certification, you will be listed on the YHS website and be able to be hired by any YHS managers as a certified support handler. Salary depends on event.
- Depending on your number of participations in events and individual progress, you will possibly move on to become a lead handler.
